Important information:

- Johnson students only
- Acts may be solo or groups
- Solo acts should have at least 1 year of training or experience in their talent.
- Solo acts are limited to 2 minutes or less. Group acts are limited to 3 minutes or less.
- Song choice will be on a first-come, first-served basis. Multiple acts cannot perform the same song. "This is Me" by Keala Settle, (from the movie *The Greatest Showman*), is not available because it is the finale song.
- Every act must have a parent or teacher coordinator who is responsible for gathering and submitting required information and supervising the act at rehearsal and the show.
- All acts must submit a CD of their music and a written sheet of lyrics by the mandatory meeting on March 22nd. Spoken word acts must submit the text of the performance by the mandatory meeting. The selection(s) are subject for approval.
- No child may participate in more than 2 acts (excludes National Anthem, Opening Act and Finale).
- Get your applications in quickly as we are limited to only 30 acts.
- All H.C. Johnson Scouts are invited to participate in the singing of the National Anthem. Scouts must submit a application form with parent's signature.
- All acts will participate in the finale and opening act. Lyrics will be distributed with confirmation.
- All acts and students in acts must register by filling out the attached application. Applications are due by February 28.
- Each student must have an application form signed by a parent.
- All music, lyrics, text, dances, costumes and act content must be age-appropriate for elementary school students.

The following information is due before the March 22 meeting:

- Song selection to be submitted for approval.
- Printed lyrics or text to be submitted for approval

The following is due before or at the March 22 meeting:

- All application forms for your group
- The Act Information Sheet for the group.
- Music on CD. Please label with act name.

Submission checklist of items due by March 22nd

- Act Information Sheet
- Application from ALL students in the act
- Music CD; please make sure your CD will play in multiple types of CD players, including your car. Please label it with the act name.
- Printed lyrics or text of the act

Please confirm that the spelling of each child's name in your act is correct on the Act Information Sheet distributed. This is needed for the program. Spelling will be taken directly from these forms.

According to district policy, any child in your act who is absent from school on the day of the show will be unable to perform that night.

Please be mindful of our school's dress code when choosing your costumes for your act. There are no dressing rooms available. If your child is performing in more than one act and needs to change, he or she will need to use the restrooms in the front of the school.

Boosters are available for sale in the program. Order forms are on the PTO website.

Performers and *one* Parent Coordinator per act do not need a ticket.

Ticket order forms will be online and also sent home. Tickets are \$5 each, including all children.

Parent coordinators must stay with their act during the show and must walk the act back to the stage.

You will receive a lineup the night of rehearsal. If you are a coordinator please make sure to arrive on time and check your group in. Please make sure you sit in your assigned seats and stay there.

If you will be using props in your routine, you will be responsible for transporting them to and from the rehearsal and the night of the show. It is also necessary for you to remove them immediately after your group's performance. We cannot guarantee that there will be a place to store them overnight at the high school.

Groups will sit in the back of the auditorium and will go backstage 5 acts before they are due to perform. They will go out the back side doors exiting between acts. There will be volunteers directing acts on where to go.

We will have the rehearsal on Wednesday, April 11. Your act needs to be there the time you are scheduled for. Please make sure that you have sent your group the link to the finale song and the opening act. Encourage them to practice the lyrics.

All acts must be at the show by 6:20pm on Friday night. Only one parent coordinator per act will be allowed into the auditorium at that time to ensure the safety of the children. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Please be prompt as we will open the doors to the audience at 6:45pm.

After the children perform they will exit the stage and sit in reserved rows in the audience. We ask that you remain with your act to ensure that all of the children are dismissed to their parents.

Please do not bring any food into the auditorium. We are responsible for any garbage left behind. The PTO will provide water for the performers.
